Ash-Composites can be used in a number of recreational applications, such as park benches, picnic tables, sign boards, etc. The pictures below show an Ash-Composite sign board made by an Eagle Scout in recognition of his alma mater, Brooks Global Studies Elementary School. The board was designed to withstand a Category 4 hurricane; the board is 6 ft wide, 1.5 ft high and 1.5 inches thick. The two posts are 7 ft long and 4 x 4 inches cross-section.
